## CONFESSION OF FAITH

Belgic Confession, Article 22  
With the apostle Paul we say that we are justified by faith alone, or by faith without works.<sup>1</sup> However, to speak more clearly, we do not mean that faith itself justifies us, for it is only an instrument with which we embrace Christ our Righteousness. But Jesus Christ, imputing to us all His merits and so many holy works which He has done for us and in our stead, is our Righteousness.<sup>2</sup> And faith is an instrument that keeps us in communion with Him in all His benefits, which, when they become ours, are more than sufficient to acquit us of our sins.
