#### **Confession of Faith**

Belgic Confession, Article 14 (part 3)

We believe that God created man good, but he willingly subjected himself to sin, corrupting his whole nature. Therefore we reject everything taught to the contrary concerning the free will of man, since man is but a slave to sin<sup>1</sup> and has nothing of himself unless it is given him from heaven.<sup>2</sup> For Christ says, *No one can come to Me, unless the Father who sent Me draws him?*<sup>3</sup> Who will glory in his own will, who understands that *the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God?*<sup>4</sup> Who can speak of his knowledge, since *the natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God?*<sup>5</sup> And therefore what the apostle says ought justly to be held sure and firm, that *God works in us both to will and to work for His good pleasure.*<sup>6</sup> For there is no will nor understanding conforming to the divine will but what Christ has produced in man, which He teaches us when He says, *Without Me you can do nothing.*<sup>7</sup>
